

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF WOLD NEWTON PARISH COUNCIL
HELD IN THE COMMUNITY CENTRE ON MONDAY 8th APRIL 2019

PRESENT:

Councillor Lockwood (The Chairman), Councillor Dr Meeson, Councillor Botterill, Councillor Robinson and Councillor Cullen.

ITEM 1 – Apologies and Declarations of Interest.

Councillor Barnes and Councillor West made their apologies for non-attendance and Councillor Robinson declared a non-pecuniary interest through his membership of the Wold Newton Parochial Church.

ITEM 2 – Minutes and matters arising from the meeting held on 4th March 2019.

The minutes of the previous meeting had been circulated to Councillors prior to the meeting. No matters arising.

ITEM 3 – Correspondence.

The Humberside Police Parish/Town updates.

Following on from last months walkabout, the taskforce schedules were distributed. Councillor Robinson and Councillor Cullen have reported that the recently repaired road on Back Street, just up from the school, has already broken away, so the Clerk will email Paula Parker to ask to add it to the streetscene schedule, also advising Councillor Jane Evison.

An email was received from the Woodland Trust regarding the community tree pack we have been accepted for.

An email advising the grit piles are no longer distributed, only the salt bins are maintained. The Clerk will contact the Technical Services team to ask for extra bins on the Fordon hill leading towards Wold Newton as the ice there never melts and is very dangerous in icy weather.

An email from East Riding regarding the extra waste bin we requested. We have been advised we need to fund this ourselves, the Clerk will contact the refuse streets & grounds dept to check it can be emptied before we buy one.

An email advising us our gullies are on the schedule for clearing on the 2019/20 list.

The Council advising us the My Account section of the East Riding website has many new forms to report any issues, for parishioners and the Parish Council.

ITEM 4 – Election of Councillors.

This week was the deadline for the re-election of the Parish Council Councillors. Each current Councillor has been nominated to stand. Due to being abroad, Councillor West has not been re-nominated but can be co-opted back on to the Parish Council on his return.

ITEM 5 – Defibrillator update.

The monies from Lissett still have not yet been received so the clerk will chase again. The Clerk held a CPR training session in the school which was attended by 5 volunteers, we will contact Wold Newton School to arrange another training session on an evening. Councillor Robinson has arranged for a solar light to be fitted.

ITEM 6 – Speeding Update

We have issued Mia Jones information regarding the Community Speed Watch, they required our preferred place and times, we agreed Bridlington Road/Laking Lane at 8-9am and 5-6pm.

ITEM 7 – Footbridge Update

We have asked James Skelton to repair the bridge. Councillor West will provide the materials.

ITEM 8 – Use of new available land

A local farmer has enquired about renting the land from the council, however, as we have already received a grant of 420 tree saplings from the Woodland Trust, we decided to keep the land for the local parishioners to share.

ITEM 9 – Planning Application Ref 19/00414/PLF - Decision

The permission has been granted.

ITEM 10 – Planning Application Ref 19/00555/TCA

This planning is to remove the poplar which will affect the soakaway in the future. We confirmed that as a parish we have no observations.

ITEM 11 – Accounts to Pay

To TPJones for payroll preparation.

ITEM 12 – Any Other Business

Councillor Cullen confirmed when the benches are to be linseed oiled and put back out in the village.

Councillor Meeson has asked if we can start chasing the council for kerbing down Front Street.
