

**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF WOLD NEWTON PARISH COUNCIL
HELD IN THE COMMUNITY CENTRE ON MONDAY 19th JULY 2021**

PRESENT:

ITEM 1 – Apologies and Declarations of Interest
