Here's an update for you on our festive services, and news on service changes we have coming up in the New Year.

We wish you all a happy and healthy Christmas, and let's hope you can get out and about with us in 2021!

Festive Buses

Our buses run to special times over the festive period.

- Wednesday 23 December normal service.
- Christmas Eve normal service, but with buses finishing around 8pm.
- Christmas Day no buses.
- Boxing Day special Boxing Day services will run as below.
 - o **Service 34**: Hull-Willerby buses via Wymersley Road.
 - o **Service 56**: Hull-Longhill buses via Holderness Road.
 - Service 63: Hull-Castle Hill Hospital buses via Priory Road and Cottingham.
 - o **Service 66**: Hull-Hessle buses via Anlaby Road.
 - Service 104: Hull-Castle Hill Hospital buses via the Avenues and Cottingham.
 - Service 154: Hull-Castle Hill Hospital buses via Anlaby Road and Willerby.
 - Service 75: Hull-Withernsea buses via Hedon, Burstwick and Patrington.
 - o Service 121: Hull-Bridlington buses via Beverley and Driffield.
 - Service X46/X47: Hull-York buses via Beverley, Market Weighton and Pocklington.
 - o **Service 12**: Scarborough-Bridlington buses via Filey.
 - o Some special services will also run around Scarborough.
- Sunday 27 December normal Sunday services will run on all routes.
- Bank Holiday Monday 28 December Sunday services will run on all routes.
- Tuesday 29 December Saturday services will run on most routes. Services 88, 360 & 361 will run normal Tuesday services. Some evening journeys on Services 18, X47, 75 & 121 will not run see details on our website. Service 143 will not run.

- Wednesday 30 December Saturday services will run on most routes. Services 88, 360 & 361 will run normal Tuesday services. Some evening journeys on Services 18, X47, 75 & 121 will not run - see details on our website.
- New Year's Eve Saturday services will run on most routes, but with buses finishing around 8pm. Services 88, 360 & 361 will run normal Thursday services. Service 143 will not run.
- New Year's Day no buses.
- Saturday 2 January onwards back to normal service.

Christmas Cheer

January: service changes and more EastRiders launched

From 3 January we'll be making changes to some services, including buses in Hull, from Hull to Hedon and Withernsea, from Hull to Brough and Goole and from Goole to Rawcliffe.

It's difficult for us to distribute timetables at the moment as many of our normal timetable outlets are closed, so any assistance you can give us with publicising these changes in your community would be much appreciated.

Buses from Goole & Brough to Hull

From 3 January our buses between Hull, Brough & Goole will change. Service 155 & X55 will change to become new EastRider Service X5 and new Service 55.

- New EastRider Service X5 will be a fast new coach service between Goole, Howden, Gilberdyke, Newport, Elloughton, Brough, Hull Royal Infirmary & Hull. It's limited stop, so you get to your destination quicker, and the coach has comfy seats, air conditioning, WiFi and plug sockets so you can make the most of your journey. Plus, you can bring your bike along for free! Find out more about EastRider Service X5.
- The new fast EastRider Service X5 will run alongside new Service 55. This
 route will continue to serve villages such as North Cave, South Cave, Welton
 & Melton, and will not also provide a link to Melton Business Park &
 Bridgehead Business Park, although it will no longer enter the centre of
 Hessle
- There'll be more buses between Gilberdyke/Newport and Hull, including on Sundays.

Buses from Withernsea & Hedon to Hull

From 3 January our buses between Withernsea, Hedon & Hull will change.

- Services 75, 76 & 77 will change to become new EastRider Service X7 and new Service 75.
- New EastRider Service X7 will be a fast new bus service between Withernsea, Hollym, Patrington, Ottringham, Keyingham, Thorngumbald and Hedon straight down Hedon Road to Hull City Centre. It's a more direct route, so you get to your destination quicker, and the buses have comfy seats, WiFi and USB chargers so you can make the most of your journey. Find out more about EastRider Service X5.
- The new fast EastRider Service X7 will run alongside EastRider Service 75, which will continue to serve villages such as Burstwick, and will use the current Service 75 route via Hedon Road and Holderness Road into Hull City Centre. The Eastrider Service 75 will also have more comfortable seats, WiFi and USB chargers.

The new bus features (USB chargers etc) will be rolled out throughout January.

Services 151, 152 & 153

Times will change for these services.

- Service 152 will now serve Hessle & Bridgehead Business Park, with more journeys at busy times.
- Service 153 will only run between Hull and Swanland, no longer serving North Ferriby.

Services 104 & 154

Sunday times for these buses will change slightly from 3 January. Monday-Saturday times will stay the same, and there are no changes to the route.

Service 88

From 4 January an extra journey will be added in each direction, and times will change to spread the journeys throughout the day.

Services 78/79

From 4 January times and routes will change for these buses, with Service 78 now serving Preston, giving more buses to this village. The Service 78 now no longer goes via the Marina and Humber View, so you'll have a quicker and more direct journey into Hull.

New Shuttle Service 178 will run between Hull, the Marina & Humber View, instead of Service 78.

Service 277

There will be minor changes to the times of Service 277. The route will not change.
