#### ITEM 4 - Public Forum - Residents Views and Comments

Councillor Bibb asked if the Parish Council had been notified of the change in Wards, he commented that we would now be part of the North Wolds and Coastal Ward. Further notification regarding this and the Councillors for these areas to be expected.

Parishioner Tansley reported that residents were still experiencing problems with noise from the Anvil Arms, these issues are to be directed to the ERYC who are aware of the situation.

#### ITEM 5 - Gas Drilling - Foxholes

It has been widely advertised that the application for the Exploration of Gas between Foxholes and Wold Newton is now current. Foxholes and Butterwick Parish Council has done a vast amount of work on publicising the Application and Apposing it. Further details regarding it can be found online. It was encouraged that anyone objecting to the application should do so individually so that as many objections are logged as possible.

The school was to be contacted to see if they had information regarding it and the implications thereafter.

Councillor Ellis asked Councillor Bibb if it would be possible to notify other Parish Councils through the Parish Open Doors of the application and let them have a copy of the leaflet devised to help anyone log an objection.

The leaflet offering guidance was to be disturbed through the Parish of Wold Newton.

The Parish Council took a vote on whether to object to the application and it was unanimous that an objection should be logged. Councillor Ellis was going to prepare a response.

#### ITEM 6 - Village Green, Pond and Pitfield Area

With the autumn and winter months now upon us it was decided to leave any clean ups to spring of 2026 when hopefully the weather and lighter nights allow. The pond still has a leak and ways to remedy this are still be investigated.

#### ITEM 7 - Grants

No further grants available at present.

### ITEM 8 - Speeding and Speed Watch

As always this remains a problem in the village with many residents showing concern. With limited funds for speed deterrents and little interest in the Speed Watch Scheme the Parish Council is limited on what can be done. This was explained at the meeting to those present.

Parishioners Taylor, Youngman and Tansley showed interest in perhaps starting the Speed Watch system going again – Clerk was to investigate on their behalf.

Councillor Bibb also advised that he may be able to get the current Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner to come to a future meeting to explore any other avenues that may be available. The Committee agreed that this would be an excellent idea.
