ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC

Church Lane, Thwing

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Church Lane, Thwing between the junction of Wold Newton Road and "Laburnum House" commencing 2nd October 2025 @ 09:00 hours to allow tree felling works to be carried out in safety.

The road closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 2nd October 2025 @ 17:00 hours.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via:

Main Street, Burton Fleming Road (Thwing), Thwing Road, Wold Newton Road (Burton Fleming), Bridlington Road, Laking Lane, Rainsburgh Lane (Wold Newton), Wold Netwon Road (Thwing) and vice versa.

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. The road will be closed to all traffic but access will be maintained for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians.
